

The principal focus of the Children's Water Festival in Rio Rancho is to educate

fourth-grade school children about water and its relationship to humans and natural resources in a fun and interactive atmosphere.

Program Vision:

- Introduce students and teachers to new ideas, options, and solutions for conserving and protecting future water supplies,
- Lay the foundation for further learning,
- Reach as many students and teachers as possible.

Public participation is essential to successful water conservation, and educating the public will promote better water conservation planning and implementation. Early education will influence the future acceptability of the concept of water conservation. This early education experience has shown that training efforts have affected behavioral changes and have improved water use practices. Water conservation goals are only as effective as the willingness of the water users to adopt and implement appropriate water conservation
